Contraction of de el

Del is the contraction of "**de e**l", meaning "of the; from the". Following are some useful rules.

- 1. When de is followed by el, the two words are combined into del: la capital **del** país (the capital of the country) la oficina **del** director (the office of the director)
- 2. **De la, de las, de los, de él** are never combined into one word: el puerto principal **de la** república (the principal port of the republic) el país **de las** pampas la capital **de los** Estados Unidos (the capital of the United States) el libro **de él** (*his* book)
- 3. When de is followed by a proper name there is no contraction: Tengo el libro **de** Felipe. (I have a book of Felipe.)
